GENERAL OBJECTIVE

Enhancing the resilience of rural communities through capacity building in agriculture and livestock, improved market access, and sustainable resource management.

PROJECT FOOTPRINT

Practical field learning, horticulture support, and livestock regeneration across 03 localities and 12 villages of Suakin, Tawkar, and Agig.

Implemented by CISP with Betay Development Organization, with support from AICS.

OPERATIONAL PACKAGE

AGROECOLOGY TRAINING

- 600 beneficiaries reached - 200 per region
- 24 sessions delivered - 8 modules per region
- 12 committees trained
- 03 demonstration farms /3 farmer field school

SUPPORT FOR HORTICULTURE AND LIVESTOCK

- 40 Tones Seeds with agricultural tools distributed to 200 families
- Promotion of high-nutrition crops, including okra (220kg)
- 450 goats/sheep distributed to 150 female farmers
- 43 Tones of Fodder supplied to support livestock regeneration

The intervention combines practical learning, input support, and regenerative livestock assistance to strengthen local production systems and household resilience.

FIELD IMPLEMENTATION HIGHLIGHTS

INTEGRATED SUPPORT PACKAGE

- 600 participants trained in agroecology
- 3 demonstration farms / 3 farmer field schools
- Seeds and tools delivered to 200 families
- High-nutrition crops promoted, including okra
- 450 goats/sheep for 150 female farmers
- Fodder supplied for livestock regeneration

The package links training, productive assets, and nutrition-sensitive support in a single resilience pathway.
